

Stipendije

Znanstveno-organizacijski odbor 26HSKIKI je, u suradnji s IUPAC-om, osigurao određeni broj stipendija putem kojih će motiviranim studenticama i studentima diplomskih i doktorskih studija (do navršenih 30 godina starosti), potpuno ili djelomično, pokriti troškove sudjelovanja na 26HSKIKI. Stipendija uključuje pokrivanje troškova smještaja za jednu osobu u hotelu Niko*** za vrijeme trajanja konferencije, što podrazumijeva 3 noćenja s doručkom (dolazak 9. travnja popodne i odlazak 12. travnja), kao i financiranje putnih troškova u iznosu do 60 USD. Svi dobitnici IUPAC-ove stipendije oslobođeni su plaćanja kotizacije.

IUPAC stipendije namijenjene su mladim znanstvenicima iz Hrvatske, BiH, Crne Gore, Srbije, Kosova, Makedonije, Albanije i Bugarske.

Obavijest o dodijeljenim stipendijama:

Kandidati će biti obaviješteni o rezultatima selekcijskog postupka za dodjelu stipendija u petak, 21. 12. 2018. godine. Svi kandidati kojima je u selekcijskom postupku odobrena stipendija, povratnim će se dopisom izjasniti prihvaćaju li ponuđenu stipendiju, u najkraćem mogućem roku, a najkasnije 11. 01. 2019. Ukoliko se kandidat ne očituje do ovog roka, smatrat će se da ne prihvaća dodijeljenu stipendiju, koja će zatim biti ponuđena sljedećem kandidatu s rang-liste kako ju je utvrdio Odbor za dodjelu stipendija. Nakon prihvaćanja stipendije, stipendist će se registrirati na <http://www.26hskiki.org/sudjelovanje/#registracija>, uz naznaku da je kategorija kotizacije: *dobitnik/ca IUPAC-ove stipendije.*

Kandidati koji prihvate stipendiju, dobit će obrazac za povrat troškova od strane Tajništva IUPAC-a. Financijska sredstva bit će uplaćena na osobni bankovni račun kandidata nakon konferencije, tj. nakon slanja popunjenog obrasca o povratu troškova, uz priložene račune, Tajništvu IUPAC-a.

Bursaries

Organizing Committee of 26HSKIKI, in collaboration with IUPAC, offers limited number of bursaries to fully or partially cover expenses of participation at 26HSKIKI to motivated graduate and doctoral students. The candidates should not be older than 30. Bursary covers expense of accommodation at the Niko Hotel*** for the duration of the main event of the conference (3 nights, arriving April 9th and departing April 12th, on a bed & breakfast basis), and travel costs valued at max. 60 USD. Winners of IUPAC scholarship do not pay registration fee.

IUPAC bursary assistance is intended to provide financial support to young researchers from Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Serbia, Kosovo, Macedonia, Albania and Bulgaria.

The application should contain the following documents: *letter of recommendation written by research/PhD supervisor, motivation letter, CV and abstract for the Conference.*

The announcement of results of selection process:

All applicants will be informed by email about the results of selection process on Friday, 21st December 2018. All bursary recipients are expected to accept or decline the offered bursary support by replying to the received email message, not later than 11th January 2019. The failure to respond by the deadline date will result in removal of the applicant's name from the list of qualified applicants, so their bursary support will be offered to the applicant who is next on the list, as defined by the Bursary committee. After the bursary support is accepted, the applicant has to register at <http://www.26hskiki.org/en/participate/> within registration category „IUPAC scholarship holder“.

To each candidate who accepts IUPAC bursary support, IUPAC Secretariat will send the Claim Form. The candidate should then complete the Claim Form and return it along with supporting receipts to the Secretariat at their earliest convenience, no later than 30 days after the end date of the Conference. After the completed Claim Form is received at the Secretariat, candidate will receive their allocated amount by check or bank transfer as requested.



IUPAC endorsement implies that entry visas will be granted to all bona fide chemists provided application is made not less than six months in advance. If a visa is not granted two months before the meeting, the IUPAC Secretariat should be notified without delay by the applicant.
